



Are you missing out on a minimum of <u>£24</u> a week?

If you are responsible for bringing up a child who is

- under 16
- under 20 and in approved education or training

Then you could <u>claim Child Benefit</u> There's no limit to how many children you can claim for

What you might be able to claim

There are 2 Child Benefit rates

Who the allowance is for	Rate (weekly)
Eldest or only child	£24.00
Additional children	£15.90 per child

If either you or your partner earns more than £50,000 a year before tax, you can still apply for Child Benefit, for more information please visit: <u>https://www.gov.uk/child-benefit/what-youll-get</u>



If you have 3 children you could get £55.80 a week

Make a claim

You can claim Child Benefit 48 hours after you've registered the birth of your child, or once a child comes to live with you. Child Benefit can be backdated for up to 3 months.

Before you start

You'll need:

- your child's birth or adoption certificate
- your bank or building society details
- your National Insurance number
- your partner's National Insurance number, if you have one

If your child's birth was registered outside the UK

You'll need to send:

- your child's original birth or adoption certificate
- your child's passport or the travel document they used to enter the UK

Any documents you send will usually be returned in 4 weeks. If you do not have the certificate you need, make a claim now and send the certificate once you've got it.
